

You will need:

Ordnance Survey map of Ireland showing your site
Transect Line
Pencil
Slope measurer
Trowel
Quadrat

River Corridor Survey

- a. Measure out a 50m length of river bank using your transect string. Mark the ends with bags or a homemade flag.
- b. Carefully examine your 50m stretch for the features shown on your river corridor survey sheet. Tick those you can see in the first column (headed "50m") of the recording sheet.
- c. Once you've completed this survey you may wish to repeat it for the next 50m. This time fill in the second column (headed "100m") on your recording sheet.
- d. Repeat this as many times as you want , up to a distance of 300m.
