

MAMMAL TRACKS

Be careful not to trample around on the river bank until you have completed this investigation – *your* footprints aren't that interesting!

- a. Use your transect string to measure out a 20m long x 10m wide stretch of river bank. Mark the corners with bags or some other easy-to-see object (how about making some flags?)
- b. Carefully examine your strip of bank for footprints. The best places to look are damp, soft areas – especially down by the river.
- c. Identify any tracks using the pictures on the identification sheet which you can view online or download. Tick the boxes to record your results.
